Admission Requirements (Onshore):

To qualify for this course, applicants should:

- (i) have a Bachelors Degree (AQF 7) or equivalent; OR
- (ii) Alternative entry via Portfolio to contain:

? Curriculum Vitae

? Valid GMAT score or Graduate Record Examinations (GRE)

? A Written statement of no more than 800 words. The statement should address reasons why enrolment in the course will enhance the applicant's early career professional portfolio

With the option of an interview for alternative entry applicants at the discretion of the Academic Chair.

No work experience is necessary, but if you have two or more years of work experience you may apply for the Master of Business Administration.
